NEW Helmets!

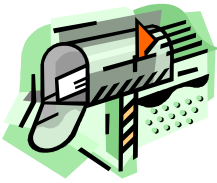

at 9 am the morning of the tournament.

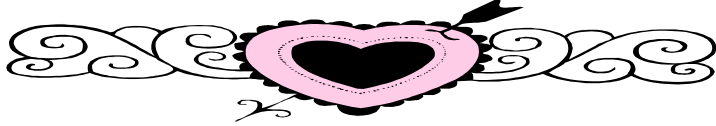

KDSA Announces SC2-010 mission is "GO" for launch



Rocky Fork Lake, Oh:
Today KDSA (KAMP Dovetail Space Agency) Executive Director Linda Allen announced that the agency's 29th orbiter mission SC2-010 is a "Go" for its scheduled launch in late June of this year. SC2-010: "Space Camp 2010" will have an open launch window between Monday, June 21, 2010 and Friday June 25, 2010 with orbiter deployment and launch site preparations starting the week prior.

Executive Director Allen explained that the criteria used in selecting astronauts for the agency's special needs missions has been narrowed down to "having a big heart" and a "willingness to learn and grow". She encouraged all prospective KAMP Dovetail Astronauts to attend the mission briefings listed [here](#) where the mission control staff will provide all of the

materials and training required to have a successful launch.

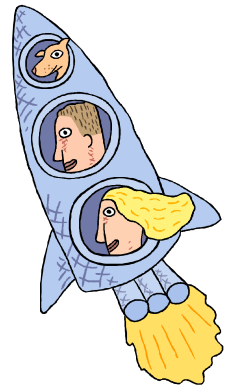
Executive Director Allen also provided a brief overview of SC2-010's mission objectives. The mission objectives will include bio-matter collection (fishing), orbiter maneuvering (horseback riding), space walks (swimming), zero gravity training (dancing), orbiter re-entry (boating), and much, much more.

KAMP Dovetail Astronauts are in training now and more are needed. It takes a long time to learn those special skills needed to be a great KAMP Dovetail Astronaut. If you are willing to learn about individuals with disabilities, are flexible, and available during the third week of June, we would love for you to enter our astronaut training program for special needs missions. Of course, some astronauts had to start out as members of the ground crew. So, if you're not sure about volunteering, give it a chance. Join us at one of our mission briefings. Our mission control staff does a terrific job of preparing astronauts for our special needs missions.
